SSPR MASTER PLAN

We are proud to share the next step in the South Suburban Park and Recreation District (SSPRD) Master Plan process. SSPRD staff and board have reviewed drafts of the Master Plan and we are inviting you as an important advisor and partner to review a final draft document. The final draft Master Plan will be available online beginning Monday, March 27 and for three weeks through Friday, April 14 at the following website:

We have spent the last year engaging the public and stakeholders through extensive community outreach, public meetings and surveys with over 1,000 responses. The Master Plan tone reflects the unifying role SSPRD plays as a provider of parks and recreation services to our diverse communities. Four guiding principles of the Master Plan include: 1) Quality First, 2) Enrich Wellness, 3) Connect to Nature, and 4) Lead Sustainability. These guiding principles are broad initiatives describing what our community aspires to achieve for parks and recreation and have evolved out of the community engagement. The Master Plan is also aligned with recent and current regional planning efforts and built off the foundation of the 2014 SSPRD Gold Medal Citizen Report and the 2013 SSPRD Strategic Plan.

Heritage Elementary School is a place of small and big celebrations. To create a positive school culture, we use one word to describe the behaviors to which we aspire. We use the word "SOAR". SOAR is an acronym for Safety, Ownership, Attitude and Respect. Safety applies to making decisions that keep us safe with bodies and feelings. Ownership is choosing to be responsible. Attitude is one's thinking made visible by the words we choose and actions we take. Respect is respecting oneself, others and the school and community. Daily, teachers have the goal of naming four to six small celebrations to children for one redirection. Also, teachers have the goal of making small celebrations concrete by giving students a "SOAR" sticker regularly throughout the week when students do "SOAR". Three times a year, the entire school body gathers for larger celebrations; our SOAR Assembly. At the SOAR Assembly, Leadership SOAR Awards are given to two students in each homeroom. A student earns The Leadership SOAR Award by consistently meeting SOAR expectations and demonstrating exceptional leadership behaviors. At the assembly, each recipient is called by name, invited to stand on the stage in front of the student body and parents to receive their certificate. At the end of the year, one student in each grade is honored with the "Eagle Feather" award. To earn the Eagle Feather award, the student demonstrated outstanding improvement in school either academically, socially or behaviorally due to the extra effort they've put in, or personal habits they've changed during the current school year. In addition to being recognized at the final SOAR Assembly, these students' names are placed on a plaque in the foyer of the school. In these ways, we celebrate students' hard work, growth and achievement.



On March 13, 2017, Heritage Elementary School had a big celebration at the Cherry Creek School District Board of Education meeting when the school earned the John Irwin Award. The John Irwin Award is given by the Colorado Department of Education to schools that demonstrate excellent academic achievement. On the School Performance Framework, Heritage Elementary School met the criteria of "exceed" expectations on the indicator for academic achievement over three years. For Heritage and other CCSD schools receiving the award, Dr. Harry Bull, Superintendent of Cherry Creek Schools said "These awards affirm the intense and focused work our faculty and staff are doing to ensure that all of our children learn, grow and achieve academically. We thank our students for their hard work and our parents and community members for providing the support and resources that enable our students and schools to be successful." This award of excellent academic achievement is because of the hard work of all students, the dedication of the entire staff and the unwavering support of the Cherry Park community. At Heritage Elementary School, we are proud to say "We are Heritage!"

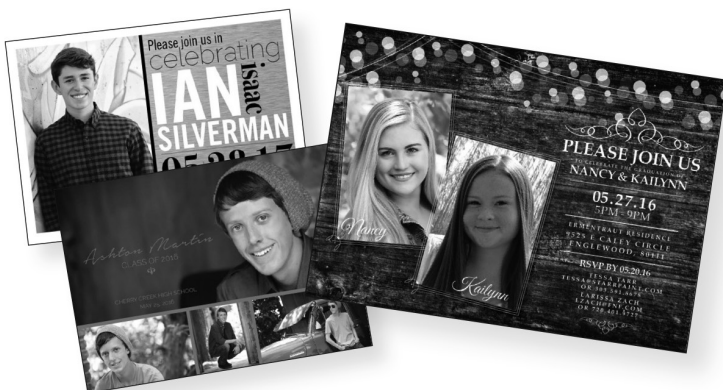

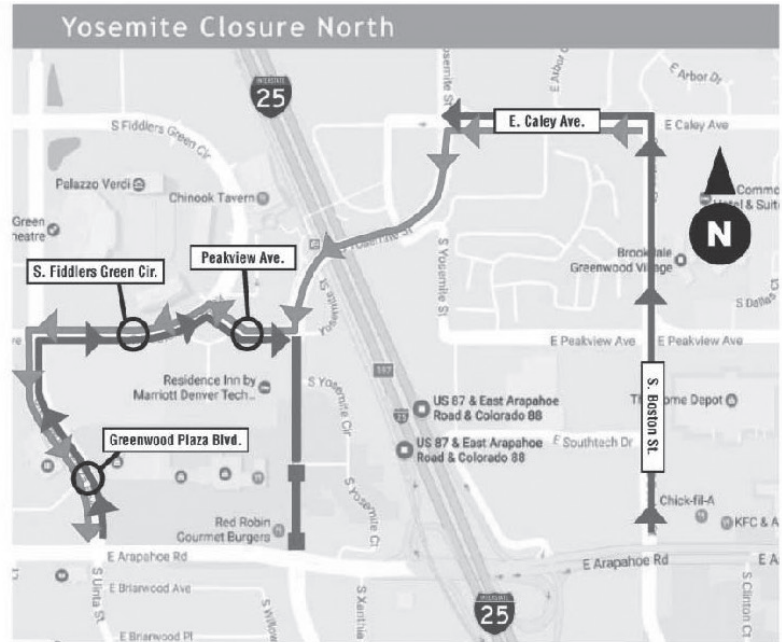
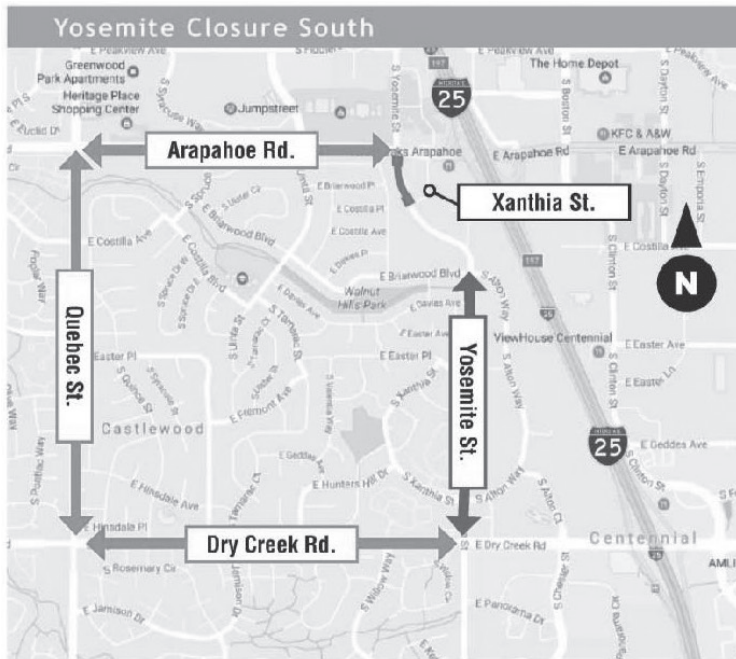
SHORT-TERM CLOSURES OF YOSEMITE STREET

To expedite work and maintain public safety while minimizing long-term impacts to Yosemite Street drivers and businesses, the I-25 and Arapahoe Road Interchange Reconstruction project will close Yosemite Street in both directions for several weeks beginning late April 2017. The first phase will close Yosemite Street from Xanthia Street to Arapahoe Road (south of Arapahoe Road) and the second phase will close Yosemite Street from Arapahoe Road to Yosemite Circle (north of Arapahoe Road). If this work was done under the condition of overnight closures it would take at least eight weeks to complete. These full closures not only enable the work to be done in a matter of 20 total days but it avoids the need to continually shift traffic and change conditions for drivers to navigate.



These closures will allow for crews to shift Yosemite Street traffic to the west so utility relocations, wall work, permanent sidewalk and curb/gutter construction can be completed on the east side of Yosemite Street. Future intermittent lane restrictions will be required to complete this work on the east side of Yosemite Street.

Please keep in mind that this work is weather dependent and subject to change. Refer to the project website codot.gov/projects/I25-Arapahoe or sign up for updates by emailing dot.i25arapahoe@state.co.us for the most up-to-date information.
