



#### STEP ONE: Make sure you are logged into your account. Click on the 3 horizontal




#### STEP THREE: Scroll all the way to the bottom of this screen. Your screen will appear different that this (i.e. your profile info, etc.).

## Neighbor To Neighbor

Your Cherry Park Home Value Update From Your Neighborhood Realtor

In the center of our neighborhood we have a great park, Cherry Park, which is maintained by South Suburban Park and Recreation (SSPR). When many covenant controlled neighborhoods around us are paying higher dues to maintain their green spaces, we pay only our taxes to enjoy our centrally located park. It's a wonderful advantage and selling point for our neighborhood.

In truth, we should do all we can to maintain a great relationship with SSPR. That is why I'm writing about a request from South Suburban's Aquatics department for public input for Districtwide aquatics master plan. SSPR had an online survey available to residents from April through May 15th. In April several neighbors from Cherry Park attended the public meeting at Goodson Recreation Center. From that meeting we were told that SSPR has four outdoor aguatics facilities. three which have reached their expected useful life (Franklin built in 1964, Harlow built in 1963, and Holly built in 1976). Cook pool in Lone Tree is their newest and most popular facility. Holly pool is the second most popular and the most central to the district. There was a rumor that Holly pool could be closed in ten years, but after that meeting it appears what is more likely to happen is that Holly pool will be reconstructed within the next few years. According to Kevin Post at Counsilman/Hunsaker, the district has 9 million dollars allocated to making improvements to its outdoor aquatics facilities. This might mean that one of the older facilities might be closed, while others are completely remodeled. We were told that SSPR will be conducting informal Q&As at their outdoor facilities this summer. Be on the look out for any questionnaires at Holly Pool. Having a great aquatics facility close by does impact our property values! Please take the time to ask questions of their assistant director of recreation, Kelsey Whisler, at KelsevW@ssprd.org.
